## **ADULT EDUCATION (AE)**

The Adult Education program at NMSU Grants provides instruction to adults (16 and over) in High School Equivalency (HSE) test preparation in either the GED or HiSET battery of tests; pre-high school and basic skills in English, reading, and math. Upon enrollment of the program, learners' skills are assessed and a learning plan is developed based on assessment results. Learners work on skill development through small group classroom instruction, computer-based learning, tutoring, and/ or self-study. All services are free of charge except the costs of the HSE tests. Enrollment requires a New Mexico ID or driver's license and a Social Security card. Learners under 18 must have parental and school board permission.
