

RELIGIOUS STUDIES - UNDERGRADUATE MINOR

Students must pass 18 credits of which at least 9 are upper division. Students must earn C- or higher grades and cannot count S/U courses unless all grades in the course must be S/U. No more than 9 credits (upper or lower division) can be earned in any one department. Students may not earn more than 3 credits total in independent studies or special readings courses and must receive approval from the minor advisor to count these credits.
